Josh Skinner – Penny Sales Tax Project Update

Mr. Skinner posed a project to Council that will replace Law Trak with a real time records management system. Greenwood county will use Penny Sales Tax funds to purchase laptops, scanners and printers to be placed in patrol vehicles. This will include Ware Shoals, Ninety-Six, County and City Police. Greenwood County will also pay for five (5) years the annual cost. After the five years this cost will be Ware Shoals' responsibility. At this time Greenwood County will need a resolution from the Council agreeing to the terms of the contract with the software company. (See Rsolution 21-01)

Resolution 20-01 – a resolution approving and authorizing the entrance into a countywide law enforcement records management system with Colossus, Incorporated (Caliber Public Safety)
